## Introduction

Exonut Uganda Limited is dedicated to enhancing a safe and sustainable environment. Recognizing the intrinsic link between human health and the health of the Environment, the organization pledges to minimize its ecological footprint by advocating for sustainable practices across its activities. To achieve this, Exonut Uganda Limited sets objectives to reduce carbon emissions, minimize waste generation, conserve water, endorse sustainable transport, integrate environmental considerations into programs, and enhance environmental awareness. Our Strategies include employing energy-efficient equipment, promoting remote work, digitizing documentation, implementing recycling programs, utilizing eco-friendly materials, advocating for sustainable transportation system. integrating environmental education into our programs, and collaborating with environmental stakeholders. All staff members are tasked with adhering to and improving environmental practices with oversight from the Operations Team and support from the Senior Management Team. This policy will undergo annual review to ensure ongoing effectiveness and relevance, reflecting Exonut Uganda Limited commitment to environmental responsibility and sustainability and peaceful eco-system restoration and Management.

Exonut Uganda Limited is committed to promoting the health and well-being of people while also protecting the environment. We recognize the interconnectedness of human health, Business and the planet's health and strive to minimize our ecological footprint by promoting environmental-friendly and sustainable practices in all aspects of our business operations. As an organization dedicated to improving the health and well-being of individuals and communities, we recognize the importance of protecting the environment and promoting environmental sustainability as emphasized in the Sustainable Development Goals 6, 7, 12, 13,14 and 15.

## Objectives of the environmental policy.

- Reduce Carbon Emissions: Develop and implement strategies to minimize carbon emissions across all organizational activities including transitioning to renewable energy sources, promoting energy-efficient equipment and advocating for sustainable transportation options.
- 2. Minimize Waste Generation and Conserve Resources: Implement initiatives to reduce waste generation, conserve water and promote recycling programs within the organization. ## Policy Area 1: Access to information and knowledge.

Information, knowledge management and development are guided by wide up-to-date and accessible information and reporting of the environmental and socio-economic state and trends.

Up-to-date and accessible monitoring of the environmental and societal conditions in the form of data collection and assessment on potential environmental and social impacts studies on priority, environmental and social issues and trends in the basin will be a key step to build a knowledge base for our work.

The body of knowledge shall be accessible to inform decision-making at headquarters and transferred to the field offices, volunteers, our staff, partners, and communities. Exonut Uganda Limited shall use this knowledge base for advocacy and awareness raising on environmental matters in our programs.

## Policy Area 2. Advocacy and awareness creation.

Advocacy and awareness raising, common understanding and consciousness of the fundamental role of environmental resources and the need for their cooperative protection and conservation of the environment will be key in our work. Exonut shall disseminate and transfer the knowledge on environmental and social conditions and reach out to the subnational and national level actors acting as a champion for coordinated and cooperative actions for the protection and conservation of shared environmental resources in the region. It shall build consciousness in sub counties around the key identified environmental and social issues and provide recommendations upon review of relevant national policies to support the dialogue in the country level.

## Policy Area 3: Environment impact Assessment

Assessment and management of environmental and social risks and impacts, Protection of the citizens, social assets and environment in the context of Exonut's interventions will be undertaken systematically. In line with national and international standards, Exonut Uganda Limited shall undertake a systematic process of assessing environmental and social risks and impacts to avoid heightening existing environmental and social challenges and to avoid, minimize and mitigate adverse impacts to the environment or to the citizens of Uganda. Within this policy area, Exonut Uganda Limited shall focus on all substantive areas possibly facing risks and impacts in the Business and project cycle, including the following dimensions:

- **3.1 Human Health:** Exonut will aim to protect the health of the people in the region by ensuring that its projects offer protection from, and do not lead to increased exposure to diseases and health hazards (including malaria, bilharzias, HIV, water pollution, air emissions etc.).
- **3.2 Water Quality:** Exonut shall strive to protect the water resources from pollution in accordance with national and international best standards that sustains the ecosystem services from them.
- **3.3 Climate Change:** Climate change is expected to significantly affect our ecosystems and livelihoods and thus an evaluation of climate change risks, impacts and vulnerability shall be undertaken either as a stand-alone evaluation or as part of the environmental and social impact assessment. All our business projects exceeding 150,000 USD shall undergo a climate-proofing to ensure their adequacy regarding future climate variability and extreme events and to make sure that the adaptive capacities and resilience in the basin are not adversely affected by the intervention.
- **3.4 Biodiversity:** Exonut Uganda Limited businesses and project shall aim to avoid significant loss or degradation of these ecosystems. An evaluation of biodiversity as part of the environmental assessment shall be undertaken and plans to deal with risks to natural habitats shall be included in the project and busines cycle.
- **3.5 Wetland Degradation:** The wetlands of the country perform crucial wide functions, including improving water quality, providing resilience against drought and flooding, and sustaining biodiversity. Wetland degradation is already a concern in many areas of the Uganda and threatens the critical ecological functions of these ecosystems. Exonut shall

aim to avoid further harm to wetlands, evaluate any possible risk to them as part of the environmental and social assessment and include plans to deal with these risks.

- **3.6 Involuntary Resettlement:** Exonut Uganda Limited will strive to ensure that its activities, programs and projects avoid the involuntary resettlement of people. Exonut will strive to ensure that when there are displaced persons, either due to land acquisition or restriction of access to resources, the affected persons are adequately resettled and compensated. Also, the activities should aim to restore their livelihoods when resettlement has occurred.
- **3.7 Public Consultation, Disclosure and Awareness:** In order to anticipate risks, Exonut Uganda Limited will be transparent in respect to public consultations, ensure disclosure of Environmental and Social Policy, and create appropriate avenues for communication, participation in decision-making processes and for raising environmental and social awareness. Here, Particular attention shall be paid to the input of women and of members of marginalized social groups.

Policy area 4: Greening the Environment: Exonut Uganda Limited is committed to Greening the environment and is considered essential for the sustenance of life on our planet. By implementing sustainable practices, conserving natural resources, reducing pollution, and preserving biodiversity, we shall create a healthier and more resilient environment for current and future generations. To the communities that we serve, we advocate for the same and always encourage tree planting and gardening in small spaces.
